

# Guidelines

- \* The School expects all pupils to wear the designated school uniform.
- \* Students must wear the regular uniform on non-PT days and sports wear on PT days. This maintains a consistent and focused environment.

The School Uniform shall consist of the following items & combination to be worn, are as follows:



Hairties/ribbons/bands - One ponytail / plait with Black / Grey Colour Ribbon.

If a student is not in the school uniform, parents are asked to meet the Principal explaining the reason. Each request will be treated on case by case basis. If a student is consistently out of uniform, appropriate procedures will be upheld.

The Class Teacher has the discretion to deal with these problems on an individual basis or refer them to the Principal for discussion. Anticipating your support and cooperation.

# Uniform: Prescribed attire with neat grooming is mandatory for all students.

- Sports dress must be worn on PET (Physical Education Training) days.
- On non-PET days, students must wear the official school uniform.

# 10. School Policies

# **Admission Policy**

# **Admission:**

**STEM** School has an open admission policy. No child is denied admission based on class, culture, religion, or belief. Admission depends on age, vacancies, and government norms.

# Withdrawal:

A written notice of three months is required to withdraw a child. Fees paid are non-refundable, either fully or partially, once the withdrawal request is submitted to the school authorities.

## **Arrival:**

School gates open 15 minutes before start time, with a 10-minute grace period. Parents or caregivers must accompany children to the handover point and wait for a teacher to receive them.

## **Dismissal:**

Parents must be punctual while picking up children. If delayed, responsible adults supervise students. Inform the school in advance for early pickup or if an unfamiliar person will collect your child.

# **Clothing:**

The uniform prioritizes children's comfort. Pre-primary parents must send labelled extra clothes for accidents. Children not toilet-trained should bring diapers daily. Personal belongings or toys are discouraged unless approved by teachers.

# **Lunch & Snacks**

Please pack only vegetarian, nutritious, and tasty snacks for your child. Teachers use snack and lunch times to reinforce learning and encourage good self-help skills in every classroom. Follow the given chart for the Lunch and snacks rules:

# Birthdays:

At **STEM School**, children can celebrate birthdays by wearing special clothes. However, return gifts and party invitations are not permitted on campus. Toffees or candies are not allowed to share with classmates.

# Festivals, Special Days and Celebrations:

Festivals at STEM School celebrate India's diversity. Children dress as per teacher's instructions, and parents are encouraged to join for authentic cultural celebrations and preparations.

# Field Trips:

**STEM** School encourages learning outside class. Parents must sign permission slips for trips, and volunteers may be requested to accompany children on neighborhood visits.

### **Accidents:**

If a child is injured, **STEM** School provides immediate first aid and contacts the parent or caregiver to collect the child. For serious injuries, the child is taken to the designated medical facility or hospital, with a staff member accompanying them if no guardian is available.

### Illness:

If a child is unwell with fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or sores, parents should keep them home and provide a medical certificate after serious illness. Medications require authorization and original containers. The school contacts parents or emergency contacts if illness occurs at school.

# Safety:

Children are supervised, and first aid kits are labeled. Emergency contacts are brought on field trips. Minor incidents are reported in writing; serious injuries are reported immediately. In emergencies or bad weather, parents are notified, and children stay under adult care until parents arrive.

# **Social Media Promotions:**

The school reserves the right to use photographs of students and parents for official promotions and advertisements, aiming to showcase achievements and events while ensuring respect, dignity, and privacy are upheld across all media platforms.

# **Behaviour Management:**

At **STEM** School, rules ensure your child's safety, using positive behavior management to set limits. Gentle reminders help guide children, with redirection if needed. Parents are informed of ongoing issues and involved in solutions. If necessary, the school counselor supports further. No physical or verbal punishment is allowed. Children are encouraged to care for themselves, others, and the environment, guided by adult role models.

### **Home School Communication:**

Home-School Communication is vital at **STEM** School. Parents are requested to use the Wisibles app to share remarks or contact the teacher. Supplementary notices will be sent as needed. Kindly acknowledge by responding or countersigning; the school will reciprocate similarly for your requests.

# **Parent Teacher Meetings:**

At **STEM** School, Parent Teacher Meetings (PTMs) and Parent Management Conferences (PMCs) are essential for tracking a child's progress. Scheduled in the calendar, these meetings foster open dialogue, address concerns, and strengthen the partnership between parents and teachers to ensure the child's academic, emotional, and social well-being.

### **PTA**

STEM School fosters strong home-school ties through an active Parent Teacher Association comprising the school head, two teachers, & elected class representatives. These members coordinate with staff and support school events, enhancing parental involvement and collaborative growth.

# Parent participation:

STEM School promotes active parental involvement through orientations, PTMs, volunteering in events and festivals, and participation in annual Eco projects and other school-led initiatives.

## \*RULES FOR STUDENTS:

**Respect & Conduct**: Students must be polite, punctual, and maintain personal hygiene.

**Discipline** : Misconduct, bullying, or dishonesty leads to strict action.

**Prohibited Items** : All Electronic Gadgets and toys are banned.

**Attendance** : 85% is compulsory; valid leave must be documented.

### 10.Parent-School Communication Guidelines

All communication between parents and the school will be exclusively through the Wisibles app starting this year. While the calendar provides important dates and policies, parents must use the Wisibles app for all messages and updates. We encourage regular app checks to stay informed and connected with teachers and the school.

# Kindly note the following:

- Your child has to bring the Calendar Hand Book to school every day.
- You are welcome to observe and understand the child's learning and teaching in school. Conferences are held to give you an insight of your child's progress at school.
- It is important that your child arrives and is picked upon time.
- Only the designated person(s) can pickup your child.
- If you decide to change the designated person on our list, kindly notify the school in advance.
- In case your child is to be absent, kindly in form the School.
- All children are required to attend school in their uniform.
- Children are required to bring a spare set of clothing in their school bag.
- Regarding contagious and infectious diseases, please follow the guidelines and refrain from sending the child to school until he/she has fully recovered.

The school requires a doctor's note stating the child is completely free from infection.

- In the event of persistent heavy rains and thunderstorms, please follow school instructions with due diligence.
- Wearing jewellery in school is discouraged. The school will not be responsible for loss of jewellery or valuables.

# 13. Grievance Redressal Mechanism

# Introduction:

Inordertoredressindividualaswellascollectivegrievancesofthestudentsandparents of the school, a grievance redressal mechanism has been established.

# What is a Grievance?

A grievance may be any kind of discontent or dissatisfaction or negative perception, whether expressed or not, arising out of anything connected with school that a student or a parent thinks, or even feels, is unfair, unjust or inequitable.

# Constitution of the Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC)

- 1. Principal & Correspondent (Chair Person)
- 2. Vice-Principal (Secretary)
- 3. Class Teachers

# Procedure for filing a formal complaint / grievance

- 1. Any student or parent of STEM School may lodge a complaint/ suggestion related to Academics/ Student Discipline / Fee & Exam related issues / other issues related to the school.
- 2. Complaint should be in writing/ by email (at <u>stemschool2016@gmail.com)</u>. The written complaints / suggestions should be dropped in complaints / suggestions box which is arranged outside the School Office. The complaint copy which is dropped in complaint box will be handed over to all GRC members on alternative days. If the complaint is not resolved within ten working days you can contact Principal & Correspondent directly or at <u>correspondent@stemschool.in</u>.
- 3. If the complaint giver does not like to reveal his/ her name for any grievance, they can drop the grievance(s) in the same Complaint Box.

# Process for addressing the Grievance

- 1. Upon receipt of complaint, the concerned people belonging to the school will send a response to the complaint giver acknowledging the receipt of grievance immediately.
- **2.** At this stage, based on the nature of the complaint and severity of its possible impact, the Chair Person may take one of the two options to proceed on addressing the concerns.
  - **a.** Option 1: Which can be exercised on matters that could be more of a routine operation:
    - i. The Secretary of the Committee may address the issue directly with the help of the concerned department.

- ii. Once the matter has been resolved the Secretary will send a final update to the complaint given on the matter.
- **b.Option2**: Which can be exercised in matters of very serious concern, in consultation with the Chairperson:
  - i. In this case, the Chair Person may also call for a deposition by the complaint giver and the person/representatives from the department against which the complaint has been made.
  - ii. Final decision of the GRC will be communicated to the student/ parent within 15 days of the receipt of the complaint.
  - iii. The Secretary of the Committee will communicate the decisions to the concerned parties/departments via email.
- 3. The Secretary will maintain an updated record of all complaints, actions taken and closure status.
- **4.** In case the complaint has been made against a member of the GRC or a member of the Appeal Committee for GRC, the concerned member will be barred from participating in any proceedings till the case is closed.

# Re-appeal:

- 1. Aggrieved parties who are not satisfied with the decision of the committee, may appeal to the Principal and Correspondent for are consideration and review within 15 working days.
- 2. The decision of the Principal and Correspondent, in such matters shall be final and there shall be no further appeal in the matter.
