This is to inform you that STEM School is going to conduct a democratic way of election for the post of SPL and ASPL. The election will be held as a replica of the assembly elections. VIII & IX Standard Students will be given a chance to stand for the election of SPL & ASPL. Class- IX Students can contest for the post of SPL. Class-VIII students can contest for the post of ASPL. Each nominee will be given a symbol. The students from grade IV to X can participate in polling votes. The Election Schedule is as follows

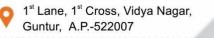

General guidelines:

A polling booth is set to check the identity cards and the index finger is marked with ink and then the students are given ballot paper for SPL/ASPL categories to cast their votes in the ballot box. The election is held in an impartial and fair manner.

Rules to be followed by the candidate:

The candidates should remember that no Social media campaigning is allowed and no advertising material is to be posted/pasted anywhere. The candidate should not use defamatory material, or spread misleading information about the other candidates. The Candidate should not do emotional blackmail or any other forms of malpractices.

A candidate's nomination can be rejected by the school if there is any violation of the above rules.

The students should agree to abide by the result of the election. The Student Cabinet is elected by a process of free and fair elections conducted in a very democratic and transparent way.

All the candidates is given a chance to campaign. Candidates are allowed to do campaign during the break time by visiting classes personally. During the campaigning process Nominees should be ready with their Election Manifesto. Manifesto to be prepared only after accepting the nomination.

Manifesto should be a 250-word statement which tells people who you are, what you desire to achieve whilst in the role and why people should vote for you.

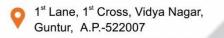
How to cast your vote?

The details are informed to you by your class teachers. Students will be given only 2 minutes to cast their votes. You should exercise on your voting rights with caution. You should enter your Name, Admission Number and Roll Number correctly in order to cast your vote. No one should vote more than once. If you do so both the votes will become invalid.

There will be a Zero Period of 1 Hour on **Wednesday, 28th June 2023** for each class. During that Zero Period you can cast your vote with the help & guidance of the class teacher.
